Thank you for your interest in the Lake Geneva Yacht Club. Before you complete this application, we would like you to know a little of the history, objectives and sailing programs of the Club.

The Lake Geneva Yacht Club was founded in 1874 and is one of the oldest sailing clubs in the Midwest. It has a history that is rich with interest in yachts, sailing events and personalities, numbering many distinguished sailors past and present.

Lake Geneva Yacht Club's mission statement is:

"The Club is organized and shall be operated primarily for the enjoyment and support of the sport of sailboat racing by Club members, their families, and guests."

To facilitate these objectives, a clubhouse is maintained as a center for sailing activity and social functions. Our grounds are used for dry land boat storage and our waterfront provides fine launching facilities including four hoists, a launch ramp and a dinghy ramp.

Club races are held on Tuesday through Sunday, and holidays from mid-May through September. Separate races are held for Classes A, E, C, MC and M17 Scows, as well as Class X, Optimist Dinghies, Lasers, Sonars, and Melges 24s. Most classes have two or three races each week. Normal weekly schedules are modified at times to accommodate regattas hosted by the Club.

The Geneva Lake Sailing School offers classes for all grades of sailors from beginner through racing skipper, both children and adults. Classes are conducted in International Optimist Dinghies, Prams, Class X, Club 420 and Sonars or students' own boats. Associate Membership Guidelines

- ✓ Associate Membership applicants must be recommended by existing LGYC members
- ✓ The base rate for Associate Members is \$1150.00 (without tax)
- ✓ Associate Members will have a \$450 minimum restaurant charges (\$150/month for the months of June, July, and August)
- ✓ Monthly minimum charges do not roll over from month to month use it or pay it
- Once Associate Members have met their \$450 minimum they will not be required to commit to any additional restaurant charges
- Associate Members will have boat launching privileges. Boat launching privileges must follow the guidelines outlined to all members:
 - Members must be cognizant of the racing schedule (i.e. no launching during pre-race launching, etc)
 - o Power and non-racing sailboats must be docked on the windward side of the piers
 - More details are outlined in the power boating guidelines available through the club manager
- ✓ Associate Members will not have voting privileges or boat slip privileges
- Associate Members who own a power boat are required to attend LGYC's power boating orientation to provide instruction on how to operate a power boat around the YC and while watching races.
- ✓ Associate Members will be required to have a valid credit card on file with the office. Credit cards will be charged for any amounts which are 30 days past due.
- ✓ Associate Members are able to convert to Regular Membership provided that meet the following criteria:
 - They must have shown an interest in sailing (e.g., purchasing a sailboat, regularly crew with a member, etc.)
 - Application will then be submitted through the normal membership application process

Trial Membership Guidelines

- ✓ Trial Membership applicants must be recommended by existing LGYC members
- ✓ One-time only Membership offering a season without dues
- Trial Members will have a \$900 minimum restaurant charges (\$300/month for the months of June, July and August)
- Monthly minimum charges are due at the beginning of each month, and do not roll over from month to month use it or pay it
- Once Trial Members have met their monthly minimum they will not be required to commit to any additional restaurant charges
- Trial Members will have boat launching privileges. Boat launching privileges must follow the guidelines outlined to all members:
 - Members must be cognizant of the racing schedule (i.e. no launching during pre-race launching, etc)
 - o Power and non-racing sailboats must be docked on the windward side of the piers
