- **SITE:** The 2012 Geneva Spring E regatta will be hosted May 19-20 by the Lake Geneva Yacht Club, 1250 South Shore Dr., Fontana, WI 53125.
- **RULES:** The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current *Racing Rules of Sailing* and the scantling rules of the National Class E Scow Association, and NCESA bylaws Articles VI and VIII, parts 4 and 5 (sailed under ILYA rules—number of crew can change from race to race). It is classified as an "invitational" Category A event in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.
- **ELIGIBILITY:** The regatta is open to Class E Scows. Eligible boats may be entered by completing registration with LGYC.
- **SCORING:** The Low Point System in Appendix A of the RRS will apply, except that RRS A2 is changed so that each boat's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races.

PRIZES: Awards will be given to the top five skippers and crew. **SOCIAL:** "Happy Hour" appetizers Friday night during registration. Saturday night dinner following last race of the day. **REGISTRATION:** At LGYC Friday, May 18 from 3:00 to 8:00P.M., and Saturday, May 19 from 8:00 to 9:30 A.M.

- **FEES:** Entries must be accompanied by check payable to the Lake Geneva Yacht Club in the amount of \$185.00 on or before May 11 or \$210.00 after May 11. This registration fee includes all racing, daily launching and haulout, dryland mooring, Happy Hour appetizers Friday night, continental breakfast and lunch Saturday and Sunday, and Saturday night's Dinner for a boat crew of 3. Additional food packages may be purchased for \$40 per person. There will be a \$10 per boat additional charge if the skipper is not a US Sailing member.
- **RACING:** The regatta will consist of as many as five races. One race will constitute a regatta. The first race start time is scheduled for 10:30 A.M. Saturday, May 19.
- **COURSES:** Racing will be windward-leeward courses with the option for a downwind finish at the discretion of the Race Committee.
