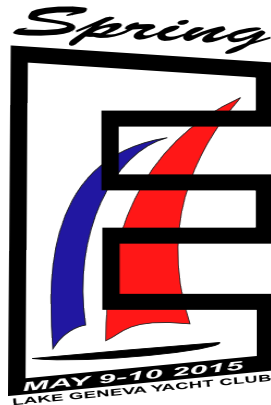

NOTICE OF RACE

SITE: The 2015 Geneva Spring E regatta will be hosted May 9-10 by the Lake Geneva Yacht Club, and held out of Gage Marine at 1 Liechty Drive, Williams Bay WI 53191.

RULES: The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the current *Racing Rules of Sailing* and the scantling rules of the National Class E Scow Association, and NCEA bylaws Articles VI and VIII, parts 4 and 5 (sailed under ILYA rules—number of crew can change from race to race). It is classified as an "invitational" Category A event in accordance with ISAF Regulation 20.

ELIGIBILITY: The regatta is open to Class E Scows. Eligible boats may enter by completing registration with LGYC.

SCORING: The Low Point System in Appendix A of the RRS will apply, except that RRS A2 is changed so that each boat's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races.

PRIZES: Awards will be given to the top five skippers and crew.

REGISTRATION: At Gage Marine Friday, May 8 from 4:00 to 7:30 P.M., and Saturday, May 9 from 8:00 to 9:30 A.M.

FEES: \$125.00 on or before April 15 or \$150.00 after April 15. This registration fee includes all racing, daily launching and haul-out by professional personnel, and dryland storage. It excludes all meals and beverages. There will be a \$10 per boat additional charge if the skipper is not a US Sailing member.

RACING: The regatta will consist of as many as five races. One race will constitute a regatta. The first race start time is scheduled for 10:30 A.M. Saturday, May 9.

COURSES: Racing will be windward-leeward courses with the option for a downwind finish at the discretion of the Race Committee.
