### NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

1.2 The scantling rules of the National E Class Association and NCESA By-laws Articles VI and VIII, parts 4 and 5 will apply. Crew changes from race to race are allowed during this event, including number of crew.

1.3 Racing rule(s) will be changed as follows:

- a) Code Flag "F," the flotation panel flag, will be in effect for all races.
- b) All races will be scored. This changes Appendix A2.

The changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.

#### 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The regatta is open to all boats of the Class E Scow class. Eligible boats may enter by completing the registration with LGYC.

#### 3. FEES

Required fees are as follows:

- \$150 on or before May 12th
- \$200 after May 12th

## 5. SOCIAL

## 6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available at Registration and on the LGYC website (LGYC.com).

## 7. VENUE

The racing area will be the navigable waters of the west half of Geneva Lake.

## 8. COURSES

Courses will be Windward-Leeward. Windward marks will have an offset mark. Races may finish downwind. Leeward gates will be used.

## **9. PENALTY SYSTEM**

Rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

## **10. SCORING**

10.1 The Low Point System in Appendix A of the RRS will apply, except that RRS A2 is changed so that each boat's total score will be the sum of her scores for all races.

10.2 One race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

## **11. RADIO COMMUNICATION**

Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

## **12. PRIZES**

Prizes will be given to the top five skippers and crew.

## **13. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
