NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.

2. ADVERTISING

- 2.1 Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

3. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1 The regatta is open to all boats of the Melges 14 class.

4. FEES

- 4.1 Registration Fee: \$125 – Included with will be one Saturday night dinner. Extra dinners may be purchased during registration.

- 4.3 Number of races: 9 Races are scheduled

- 4.4 The maximum number of races that can be sailed a day is 4.

- 5.4 If three races have been sailed. No Races will start after 1330 June 17th. No Race will start after 1500 June 17th.

5. MEASUREMENTS

Each boat shall abide with measurement standards laid down by the Melges 14 Class.

6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after June 14th, 1200 at Lake Geneva Yacht Club notice board.

7. VENUE

8.1 Sailing will take place on the navigable waters of Geneva Lake.

8. SCORING

8.1 1 race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

8.2 There will be no throw out.

9. BERTHING

Boats shall be dry sailed at the Lake Geneva Yacht Club.

10. RADIO COMMUNICATION

A boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications. This restriction also applies to mobile telephones.

11. PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows: Top 3 in Gold, Blue and Red Division's.

12. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Sailing is an activity that carries with it an inherent risk of damage and injury. Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
